Although paper is surprisingly strong for how thin it is, if the cover of a book is unable to protect the pages within adequately, it is not unusual for these pages to exhibit tears, soiling, and tattering.*

*Introduction to Paper Repair teaches a range of repair techniques useful to anyone interested in learning the elements of book repair. The course includes noninvasive surface cleaning methods, tear repair, and several techniques for dealing with pressure-sensitive tape that has been applied to pages.*
